From student to full-time employment

“My journey at headspace started in February 2020 when I volunteered to run some group programs and then in May 2020 when I came on board as a psychology student completing my final placement. I was low-key terrified to start working with teenagers, but it turns out that I loved it.

The experience was made more enjoyable by the team of committed and passionate staff at the centre and the opportunities that were offered to me. As a student, I couldn't have wanted more. But more was offered! Towards the end of my placement I started working one day a week, which eventually became 3 when I had finished my placement. I wasn't yet registered as a psychologist but was able to work in a youth care coordinator role.

Fast forward to the end of the year, finally registered but unsure where I wanted to work, or what I wanted to do. All I knew was that I wanted to start my career as a psychologist. It just so happened that positions were available at the centre for a mental health clinician, a position which I applied for and got! Here I am six months later, now a clinical psychology registrar and loving the work I do and the team that supports me.
