The Integrated Care Coordination (ICC) program is for people living with chronic disease and experiencing associated complex healthcare needs.

We will assess your healthcare goals and support with the following:

- Work with you, your relevant carers, support services and your GP
- Support you to navigate the healthcare system
- Liaise with other local service providers to ensure you are accessing the right services
- We will support you to understand your chronic condition, such as diabetes

How to access

To be eligible for the ICC program, you must be needing help to manage your medically diagnosed chronic health condition.

You also need to:

- Ask your service provider or GP to complete a referral form OR
- Contact us to complete a self/carer referral

What will happen?

A care coordinator will contact you to arrange an appointment either at your GP's practice or your home.

This program is not funded for long-term care.
