

Positive Behaviour Support

RAM (Resource Allocation Model) packages

The following sample packages are designed as flexible support options and can be adapted based on needs.

Package 1: Classroom package

Supports positive behaviour across the whole classroom. Includes:

- Classroom observations across multiple visits (5 hours)
- Functional behaviour assessment for students needing extra support (4 hours)
- Preventative and early intervention strategies (2 hours)
- Escalation response strategies (2 hours)
- Environmental based strategies to support learning (2 hours)
- Outcome reports to support NDIS access where appropriate (5 hours)

Package 2: Disability education session

Builds staff and parent understanding of disability and behaviour support. Includes:

- Initial consultation to identify focus areas (1 hour)
- Development of a tailored training package (4 hours)
- Training session with Q&A (3 hours)
- Sessions can be delivered for teachers, SLSOs and parents.

Package 3: Student specific package

Targeted support for individual students with ongoing behaviour needs. Includes:

- Observations across learning environments (2 hours)
- Functional behaviour assessment (2 hours)
- Prevention and early intervention strategies (2 hours)
- Escalation response strategies (2 hours)
- Environmental based strategies (2 hours)
- Outcome report to support NDIS access where appropriate (2 hours)

Package 4: Parent assistance package

Supports consistency between school and home. Includes:

- Observation of the child across environments (4 hours)
- Initial consultation with parents or carers (1 hour)
- Development of a home based behaviour strategy plan (4 hours)
- Outcome report to support NDIS access where appropriate (2 hours)
